Aubrey Nyman, the son of one of the residents, sang for the residents.


Gerhard Albertain not only assisted with the braai but also donated 2 000 boxes of tissues to the home.

Tehuis sorg goed vir oues

Wanneer 'n tehuis sorg met geskiedenis van 'n paar dekades, weet jy daar word in vrede en veiligheid goed omgesien na die inwoners.

Huis Dien Bothma in Boksburg is op 1 November 1970 geopen, maar die Boksburg-tak van die Suid-Afrikaanse Vroudefederasie (SAVF) bestaan al van 1911. Dien Bothma, na wie die tehuis genoem is, was van 1929 lid en tussen 1949 en 1980 voorstitter van die SAVF.

Desedlas sorg dat te huise is met 65 kamers wat sowat 124 inwoners huisves, terwyl daar ook nog 26 woonstelle op die terrein is waar bejaarde woon wat na huseit kom omision. 'n Nuwe vleuel is verlaat jaar geopen waar tussen 18 en 20 bejaarde gehuise word wat spesiale sorg benodig.

"In Workmag van sowat 85 mense, van skommakers en tuinwerkers tot Tickle Mertens, die bestuurderes, lewer gehalteborg.

Volgens Vivienne Tauta, finansiële hoof van die tehuis, is geldsake altyd 'n teer punt.

"Onverwagte noodgevalle waar vinnig voorstiening vir nuwe inwoners gemaak moet word, is 'n groot uitdaging," se Tauta. – Wolfram Zweicker
